### **Return to School**

Kenton School will reopen to students 8.25am on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2024.

From January there will be a small change to our detention system. Students will no longer be collected for their after school detention by a senior member of staff. Instead they will be expected to take responsibility for arriving at detention themselves. Detentions will continue to take place the day after a C4 has been issued. If students do not attend their detention they will be placed in our C5 reflection room the following day. As always, your support in ensuring your child attends an after school detention is very much appreciated. Please also discuss the reasons for any C4 detention with your child.

### **Uniform**
