Above and Beyond Find a local charity shop/community event and volunteer there to help others.

Option 1 Create a leaflet to show Newcastle why we should have equality in our community and how some religions might try to help with this.

Computer Studies: Websites

Above and Beyond: Create a poster explaining the use of the master slide tools to create a template for your website pages. Make the benefits of doing this clear in terms of making development simpler and how it supports the creation of a professional looking website.

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Science: Respiration and Photosynthesis

Above and beyond Write a 'Dear diary' entry as a child labourer in the Industrial Revolution.

Option 1 Create a storyboard to show who the Luddites were and what they did.

Technology: Bike Repair Tool

Above and Beyond Have your photograph taken in front of a well-known steel structure in Newcastle.

Option 1 Create a research page on steel, use colours and bold titles to make it look interesting. Include: types of steel, steel properties & product examples.

Geography: How is population changing?

Above and Beyond Create a newspaper article about the impacts of the UK's ageing population

Option 1 Research how migration numbers have changed over time – why is this a good thing for the UK economy?

French: T'es branché

Above and Beyond Watch a French language film and write a review.

Option 1: Write a list of types of TV programmes in French and give examples of each. E.g. les dessins-animés= The Simpsons

Drama: Introduction to Pantomime

Above and Beyond Attend a pantomime taking a photograph of you at the theatre.

Option 1 Creatively present what you've learnt about pantomimes from lessons and your own research. For example a video blog, model of a feature or presentation.
