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Maths:

Art: Art & Power

Above and Beyond Make an artwork about something you are passionate about. You can use words and image, any choice of media and 2D or 3D. You can take inspiration from any of the artists we've looked at this year or your own choice.

Option 1 Choose an artwork by Bob & Roberta Smith and make your own version with your choice of colours and text.

Music: Music for Adverts 2

Above and Beyond Create a piece of music using soundtrap or garageband. Your piece of music should include a drum beat, bassline and a melody.

Option 1 Complete the quiz on Microsoft forms for the topic 'Music for adverts 2'.

RE: Evil

Above and Beyond Research and then annotate a newspaper articles; that demonstrate Natural and Moral Evil (you will need one of each).

Option 1 Draw a cartoon strip with annotations of an example of "Natural Evil".

Computer Science Scratch

Above and beyond Produce a poster that describes the programming constructs sequence, selection and iteration. On the poster include pictures of the blocks that you would need to use to include these constructs in your programs. (Or simple programs using them).

Option 1 Produce a user guide on how to use the scratch interface. Explain how to use blocks in the scripting area, how to change sprite and how to select a new backdrop.

Above and Beyond Can you make a battery out of lemons? • Research how and with adult help, see if you can safely build your own! • Take photos and / or describe how you got on.

Option 1 Research Cragside • Who was Lord Armstrong? • Why is Cragside an important piece of history for electrical engineering? • Perhaps visit Cragside if you can and write up what you find.

History: Imperialism and Occupation: India

Above and Beyond Research a country of the British Empire and find 10 facts about it.

Option 1 Create a commemorative paper plate to show key facts about the British Empire.

Technology: Nutrition and Health

Above and Beyond Create a shopping list of nutritional food you would recommend buying for a food bank and explain why.

Option 1 Plan a daily food diary where you will be eating varied vitamins and minerals.

PE Tour de France, Wimbledon and Cricket 2025

Above and Beyond Research a tennis player playing in Wimbledon, a cyclist racing at the Tour the France or a cricketer in a Test Match and create a fact file poster on them.

Option 1 – Take part in either athletics, tennis or cricket club.

Above and Beyond: Design a new awareness day for British Values- think about posters/events/logos.
